Robert "Bob" Paudert began his law enforcement career in Tennessee with the Shelby County Sheriff's Department in February of 1966 at the age of 21. He served 25 years with SCSD in the Jail Division, Patrol, Metro Narcotics, Metro Aviation and the Internal Security Unit. He left the SCSD in 1990 as Assistant Chief. Between 1991 and 1998 he served as Chief of Police in both Bartlett, Tennessee and Rogersville, Missouri. Then, after a year with the Mid-States Organized Crime Information Center, he took on the role of Chief of Police of West Memphis, Arkansas, where he remained until his retirement in August of 2011.
